

MAKE YOUR OWN BIRD FEEDER HOW-TO GUIDE



Why not recycle an empty Robinsons Be Natural™ bottle and make your very own Bird Feeder.
Keep a list of the different birds you spot...

You will need..

- An empty Robinsons Be Natural™ bottle
- Scissors
- 2 long strong twigs
- String
- Bird Seed
- An adult to help you!

- 1)** Ask an adult to help you cut two round holes in the top half of the bottle, and two holes in the lower half of the bottle. Make sure they are wide enough to squeeze the twigs into. Also cut a few small holes all over the bottle for the birds to eat the seeds from.



- 2)** Poke a long strong twig between both of the two sets of holes at the top and bottom of the bottle. The birds will use these twigs to perch on.



- 3)** Ask an adult to help you make a hole in the lid and thread a piece of string through it. Tie a tight knot at the end of the string. You can use this to hang the bird feeder up once it's finished.



- 4)** Carefully pour some bird seed into the bottle and screw the bottle top on tightly.



- 5)** Ask an adult to help you hang your feeder up from a tree or your washing line, and remember to keep it full. Birds will come to rely on it and will go hungry if you forget!
